Regarding Revisions to IX Service Pricing

Japan Internet Exchange Co., Ltd. (JPIX, Headquarters: Chiyoda Ward, Tokyo, CEO: Yoshiki Ishida) will revise its IX port service pricing starting Tuesday, April 1, 2008.

JPIX was founded as the first commercial internet exchange in Japan, and has provided an environment in which ISPs can exchange traffic with each other in the form of IX port services. Last year, in June 2007, JPIX observed ten years since its founding, and in the intervening time it has tried to accommodate ever-increasing traffic by building a distributed IX and providing high-speed ports, and is now used by customers from over 110 companies consisting of major domestic and overseas ISPs and other organizations, with the volume of exchange traffic now reaching a peak value of 100 Gbps.

To make its IX port services available to more customers while trying to bring about further improvements to their convenience, JPIX is making the following revisions to monthly pricing.

Additionally, pricing for JPIX Nagoya, which provides IX port services in coordination with KMN Corporation (Headquarters: Minato Ward, Tokyo, CEO: Naoki Kobayashi), is also going to be revised in line with the revisions.
