JPIX Announces the IPv6 Commercial Service

Japan Internet Exchange Co., Ltd.(JPIX, Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, CEO: Yoshiki Ishida) and Intec NetCore, Inc.(Headquarters: Koto-ku, Tokyo, CEO: Takashi Arano) today has announced a new additional services on the IX port. This will enable JPIX customers to choose from “IPv4 native”, “IPv6 native” or “IPv4/IPv6 dual stack” with the current IX port services. Intec NetCore has been assisting this work jointly with JPIX since last December. In line with the commencement of this commercial service, the previous IPv6 trial service will be terminated.

With this “IPv4 native”, “IPv6 native” and “IPv4/IPv6 dual stack” services, JPIX will able to provide dedicated contract-based port selection and service protocol oriented filtering. JPIX will also continue providing “Option Services” for our customers’ convenience with free of charge.

- ◇ Service Start: September 1, 2008
(The appointed date of delivery will be noticed at service estimation)
- ◇ Service Site: JPIX Metropolitan (without JPIX Nagoya and JPIX Osaka)
- ◇ Offered Services: “IPv4 native”, “IPv6 native”, “IPv4/IPv6 dual stack” will be provided with IX Port Services (10Gigabit Ethernet, Gigabit Ethernet, Fast Ethernet)
- ◇ Remarks: For the stable and reliable service, JPIX will allocate users to a dedicated service ports with appropriate filtering for each customer.
