## JPIX, an IX provider, will add the new IX port service 100 Gigabit Ethernet port to its service list

The Company will adopt the Brocade MLXe Series

Japan Internet Exchange Co., Ltd., (hereafter referred to as "JPIX"; headquarters: Chiyoda-ku Tokyo; CEO: Yoshiki Ishida) an IX provider that has a largest number of customers in Japan, will launch a new IX port service, 100 Gigabit Ethernet Port, in July. Brocade Communications Systems, K.K., (hereafter referred to as Brocade; headquarters: Chiyoda-ku Tokyo; President: Masakazu Aoba) announces that it provides the Brocade MLXe Series, deployed as switch to support the new service.

As a result of Brocade's feasibility testing for various interfaces, it was proven that the 100 GbE Port Service can be provided through main interfaces, including 10×10, 100G Base-LR4, and 100G Base-ER4.

JPIX continues to strive to provide effective services and quality leading to stable operation, which can satisfy customers, such as ISPs and content providers, in order to respond to continuously increasing Internet traffic.
